# Putting borders around every article defeats their purpose. Instead, use them to highlight a particularly important article.

#### Membership

Ok, it's November. The big push for new members is over. So, what can you do now to encourage those parents who haven't already joined to do so? Sometimes people simply need a little extra motivation to send in their dues.

What incentives do you offer to parents and/or students whose parents join? If you are a PTSA, consider "members only" events for students who are members of your PTSA, or offer discounts to PTSA events for your student members.

If you are a PTA, consider offering an incentive to any homeroom that achieves 100% membership—a pizza party, sno cones, etc. Then, when a class gets really close, send a note home letting parents know the class only needs 3 more memberships to have a free party.

You can also consider offering incentives to any teachers whose classes reach 100% membership. Your teachers, especially at elementary schools, will have more contact with the parents and their encouragement can go a long way toward getting parents to join.

When classes do reach 100%, make a big deal out of it. Announce it in your newsletter, on your marquee, on a display board in the hall, and even on your morning show. Display pictures of the students enjoying their pizza or sno cone party.

The incentives don't have to be expensive, but you need to advertise them well so students, teachers, and parents are all aware of them.
