

What is ESE?

Exceptional Student Education

Exceptional Student Education is specially designed instruction and related services that are provided to students with disabilities and students who are identified as gifted.

What is The ESE Parent Rep Initiative?


- Join Initiative from Hillsborough County Council PTA and Superintendent's Advisory Council for the Education of Students with Disabilities
- Adding a Parent Rep to the PTA
- Training and supporting PTAs/Parent Reps

Why ESE Parent Reps?

- Improve communication and inclusion of ESE families
- Strengthen connection between ESE families, staff, and school
- Provide peer support and a shared voice for ESE parents
- Increase ESE family engagement, involvement, and participation in school activities
- Enhanced sense of community (beyond Awareness to Acceptance)

How You Can Be Involved

- Become the parent rep for your PTA
- Help recruit/support parent rep for your PTA
- Join the committee (create resources/tools)
- Help charter a county-wide SEPTA (Special Education PTA)

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Encourage ESE survey participation

In other words...

The ESE Parent Rep serves as a bridge between ESE families and the school community. Their role is to strengthen communication, increase engagement, and promote inclusion.

- Attends PTA meetings to represent ESE family needs and perspectives
- Encourages ESE families to complete school surveys to provide feedback
- Brings concerns from ESE parents to the principal, ESE staff, and teachers
- Collaborates with PTA/staff to modify school activities so ESE students can join

Connect with the School



- Meet with school leadership and ESE Staff
- Gather input on how you can support ESE families

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- Build awareness of your role
- Connect with ESE families
- Gather contact info and input on needs



- Keep ESE families informed
- Share resources/events
- Regular communication

Ultimate Goal

Build the ESE Community

Host activities/events

Connect With the School Meet with administration and ESE staff

- Meet with principal, Assistant Principal, guidance counselor, etc.
- Meet with ESE teachers and support staff
- Get recommendations on connecting with parents
- Gather general demographic information (how many students have IEPs, student representation, etc.

Connect With ESE Families

Announce Your Role and Gather Info

- PTA social media, website, meeting announcements
- Send home flyers with students
- Hold a "meet and greet" event
- Survey families on needs (including district ESE surveys)
- Create a contact list, FB group, etc.
- Build committee of like-minded parents/PTA members

Share Information & Resources

Maintain Regular Communication

- Share the calendar of school events and accommodation info
- Create FAQs for school events that provide more info to ESE families
- Send info/resources through email, social media, flyers
- Share community ESE resources (CARD events, Sunshine Sundays, etc.)
- Informational sessions, community classes, training opportunities

Build the ESE Community

Provide Opportunities for Connection

- Increase advocacy efforts
- Plan networking events, support groups, etc. for ESE families
- Organize activities to foster inclusion (including existing PTA/school events)
- Check in regularly with ESE staff/teachers
- Create educational opportunities to foster acceptance, not just awareness

Time Commitment

The time involved will vary depending on your school, the PTA, and needs of your ESE families. But remember, this is a committee, so the Parent Rep does not need to do it alone.

Where time is spent?

- Attending PTA meetings (several times a year)
- Meeting with ESE teachers, admin, and parents (several times a year)
- Reviewing school events to help add layers of inclusively (est. 30 mins per event)
- Share existing or create new resources (few minutes to few hours a month)
- Create events, hold committee meetings, etc. (few hours a month)
